### Policy Statement

In response to Maryland State Department of Education Bylaw 13A.05.02.13I the Board of Education has established the Allegany County Special Education Citizens Advisory Committee for the purpose of advising the local school system on the needs of students with disabilities within the jurisdiction.

The Special Education Citizens Advisory Committee may be comprised of representatives of the community, including parents/guardians of students with and without disabilities enrolled in the public school program, health care providers, students, elected officials, educators, agency representatives and members of professional and civic organizations.

Each year the local school system shall submit to the Maryland State Department of Education a budget for the use of federal funds, that shall be annually allocated by the Department to local school systems to support the activities of the local Special Education Citizens Advisory Committee, consistent with Section C(1)(a) of the regulation.
