Policy Statement

The Board of Education may conduct a summer school program each year. Its purpose is to provide additional opportunities for pupils to receive remedial instruction and participate in enrichment activities.

Summer school attendance does not in any way guarantee promotion for pupils. They may, however, earn credits toward high school graduation that may result in a revision of class placement in the high school.

The Board of Education has identified the following purposes for summer school programs:

- A. Assist those pupils who need to strengthen scholarship or to review work for credit
- B. Assist students in need of remedial assistance with state assessments
- C. Aid in the continued progress of those children who need special education services
- D. Offer enrichment experiences through subjects or courses difficult to schedule in the regular school program
- E. Afford opportunities to pursue studies for personal development and for constructive use of leisure time
