

ADMINISTRATION IN THE ABSENCE OF POLICY

Purpose

To authorize the superintendent or designee to act in situations for which there are no written policies

Definitions

Policy Statement

The Board of Education recognizes that it is not possible to anticipate all situations by providing applicable policies. School administrators who must deal with situations not covered by existing policies should consult with the superintendent.

The superintendent is authorized to make such emergency decisions on matters not addressed by Board policy as she/he may find necessary in the public interest. Any necessary action should be taken and reported by the superintendent to the Board of Education at the first opportunity.

The superintendent will recommend at a Board meeting whether or not a policy should be written to cover similar incidents.
