Purpose

To establish that non-instructional support services are essential to a successful school system

Definitions

Non-instructional Support Services – include operations, maintenance, transportation, and food services.

Policy Statement

The Board of Education recognizes that non-instructional support services are essential to the educational function of the school system. The Board expects non-instructional support services to maintain high standards of safety, to promote the health of pupils and staff, to reflect the aspirations of the community, and to support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide good instruction.

The Board:

- a. Serves as the trustee of school facilities
- b. Manages school business operations
- c. Shall establish a thorough, effective, and economical maintenance program that includes school sites, plants and equipment
