Policy Statement

In order to protect facilities and grounds and ensure the right of all students to learn without disruption or interference from unauthorized persons or groups, the Board will adhere to all federal, state, and local laws prohibiting trespassing on school premises or disturbing the normal operation of educational programs and activities.

The school administration is responsible for determining whether police protection is necessary for after-school or evening activities at which students and/or members of the community are anticipated to attend. All personnel are responsible for the security of buildings, grounds, equipment, and monies entrusted to them. Each school is responsible for the development of a security plan that may be reviewed at the school site.

All exterior doors, to the school, except main front doors, should be secured.

Schools will reemphasize that visitors must register at the main office where all individuals will be issued passes or badges to visit.
