

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

Purpose

To identify restrictions for the use of private vehicles to transport students

Definitions

Policy Statement

The Board of Education discourages transporting students in private vehicles for school activities including program trips, extra curricular and co-curricular activities. If the use of private vehicles by anyone (e.g., faculty/staff, parents, volunteers) becomes necessary, permission by the school principal must be obtained. At a minimum, parent permission forms must be completed before anyone is allowed to transport students in privately owned vehicles.

The owner of the private vehicle will assume primary responsibility through his/her own insurance carrier. The Board will provide excess insurance coverage that will cover a claim exceeding the limits of the vehicle owner's policy. The limit of liability for vehicle coverage is a combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage of \$1,000,000.
